Delete from the Letters Patent of the Corporation issued June 18, 2003, the Special Provisions beginning on page three with the words "The corporation shall be carried on" and ending with the words "are beneficial to the

Add the following Special Provisions:
Commercial purposes, if any, included in the articles are intended only to advance or support one or more of the non-profit purposes of the corporation. No part of a corporation's profits or of its property or accretions to the value of the property may be distributed, directly or indirectly, to a member, a director or an officer of the corporation except in furtherance of its activities or as otherwise permitted by this Act.
Upon the dissolution of the Corporation and after satisfying the interests of its creditors in all its debts, obligations and liabilities, its remaining property shall be distributed to another public benefit corporation with similar purposes to its own, a Canadian body corporate that is a registered charity under the Income Tax Act (Canada) with similar purposes to its own, the Crown in right of Ontario, the Crown in right of Canada, an agent of either of those Crowns or a municipality in Canada.
The corporation is authorized to establish two (2) classes of members, namely the Class "A" Members and the Class "B" Members. Each Class "A" Member is entitled to receive notice of, attend and participate at all meetings of members and has the right to one (1) vote at each meeting of the members. Each Class "B" Member is entitled to receive notice of, attend and participate at all meetings of members and has the right to one (1) vote at each meeting of the members.
Subject to the Act and the By-laws of the corporation, to effect any action under the Act, each of the Class "A" Members and the Class "B" Members must separately approve such action by the number of votes prescribed in the Act and/or the By-laws of the corporation.
